Home Association Rules

NFHA deed restrictions prohibit any free-standing structure, which include clotheslines of any type, on a resident's property. It also includes basketball goals, however the current and previous Boards have chosen not to enforce the basketball goal restriction.

The Board has received several complaints from residents regarding neighbors harassing them about their dogs. The City of Overland Park has adopted the following regulation governing dogs and leashes:

"If the dog is in the physical presence of its owner and on that person's property and under direct and immediate voice control" then the dog does not need to be on a leash (it's okay for dogs to be in the front yard). "If confined by an electronic fence or collar" the dog does not need to be on a leash. The Board is asking residents to please not call Animal Control when dogs are within the boundaries of the above regulations.

A reminder: Please do not allow dogs or cats to urinate or defecate on someone else's property --this is simply common courtesy!!
